To be eligible for US Direct Loans, students must be studying a degree granting programme at least half time (i.e. undertaking at least 50% of a full time programme). Students must be physically in attendance at either of the University of Reading's Whiteknights, London Road or Greenlands campuses in the UK to be eligible. Students undertaking a course via Distance Learning (or via any method involving telecommunications rather than physical attendance) are not eligible for Federal Student Aid.

A number of courses shown in the University's Prospectus and under the Study section of our website are not available to International students on Tier 4 Student Visas.
